Subject: Emergency Water Restriction Order

Pursuant to the authority outlined in 36 Code of Federal Regulations 1.5(a)(1), which provides that the superintendent may “Designate areas for a specific use or activity or impose conditions or restrictions on a use or activity”, the following areas of Bryce Canyon National Park will be placed on a water restriction due to the sewer lagoons reaching capacity.

Immediate Park Wide Water Conservation Measures:

- Bryce Canyon Lodge will move to a dining operation by serving visitors on disposable plates and cutlery reducing the need to run commercial dish washing.
- The RV dump station will be closed for the remainder of the season.
- All residents in the park will take the following actions:
 - Reduce shower times
 - Turn water off while brushing teeth
 - Utilize low water cleaning techniques

Bryce Canyon’s sewer lagoon treatment system is critical to the park operation. These actions may be modified and additional restrictions may be implemented based upon current conditions. Additional orders will be issued in the event of a modification or if restrictions can be lifted.
